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Measure	Definition
Controlling High Blood Pressure <140/90	This HEDIS measure is the percentage of members 18-85 years of age who had a diagnosis of hypertension (HTN) and whose blood pressure (BP) was adequately controlled (<140/90)
Cardiovascular LDL-C Control <100	This HEDIS measure is the percentage of members 18-75 years of age who were discharged alive for acute myocardial infarction (AMI), coronary artery bypass graft (CABG), percutaneous coronary interventions (PCI) from January 1 – November 1 of the year prior to the measurement year, or who had a diagnosis of ischemic vascular disease (IVD) during the measurement year and the year prior to the measurement year, whose LDL-C level was controlled to < 100mg/dL during the same time period.
Diabetes Care: HbA1c Control <8%	This HEDIS measure is the percentage of members 18-75 years of age with diabetes (type 1 and type 2) who had HbA1c control of less than 8%.
Diabetes Care: LDL-C Control <100	This HEDIS measure is the percentage of members 18-75 years of age with diabetes (type 1 and type 2) who received lipid level control (LDL-C<100 mg/dL) testing.
Diabetes Care: High Blood Pressure Control <140/80	This HEDIS measure is the percentage of members 18-75 years of age with diabetes (type 1 and type 2) who had a most recent blood pressure measurement <140/80 mm Hg.
Diabetes Care: Poor HbA1C Control (>9%)	This HEDIS measure is the percentage of members 18-75 years of age with diabetes (type 1 and type 2) whose HbA1c control was poor. <i>A lower rate indicates better performance.</i>
Cardiovascular LDL-C Screening	This HEDIS measure is the percentage of members 18-75 years of age who were discharged alive for acute myocardial infarction (AMI), coronary artery bypass graft (CABG), percutaneous coronary interventions (PCI) from January 1 – November 1 of the year prior to the measurement year, or who had a diagnosis of ischemic vascular disease (IVD) during the measurement year and the year prior to the measurement year, who received an LDL-C screening during the measurement year.
Persistence of Beta Blocker Treatment After a Heart Attack	This HEDIS measure is the percentage of members 18 years of age and older who were discharged from the hospital after surviving a heart attack and who received persistent beta-blocker treatment.
Diabetes Care: HbA1c Testing	This HEDIS measure is the percentage of members 18-75 years of age with diabetes (type 1 and type 2) who had received Hemoglobin A1c (HbA1c) testing.
Diabetes Care: LDL-C Screening	This HEDIS measure is the percentage of members 18-75 years of age with diabetes (type 1 and type 2) who received lipid level (LDL-C) testing.
Diabetes Care: Medical Attention for Nephropathy	This HEDIS measure is the percentage of members 18-75 years of age with diabetes (type 1 and type 2) who received medical attention for nephropathy (kidney disease).
Diabetes Care: Eye Exams	This HEDIS measure is the percentage of members 18-75 years of age with diabetes (type 1 and type 2) who had an eye exam performed.
